1. Gweddi

Agorodd Richard y cyfarfod drwy ddarllen dameg y Mab Afradlon a'n cynorthwyo i feddwl am gariad, gras a maddeuant di-ddiwedd y Tad. Unodd y cyfarfod gyda'i gilydd i weddio Colect newydd a ysgrifennwyd gan Mr Siôn Rhys Evans, Ysgrifennydd yr Esgobaeth, yn seiliedig ar fywyd Sant Madryn.

Minutes of the Bro Madryn Annual Vestry Meeting held on Wednesday, 20th April, 2016, in St David's Church, Nefyn

The meeting was chaired by the Rev'd Richard Wood.

In the absence of Jacquie Hughes Jones, the Secretary, who sent her apologies, the Vestry Meeting agreed that Naomi Wood would stand in for this meeting as Secretary.

1. Prayer

Richard opened the meeting by reading the parable of the Prodigal Son and helping us to think about the Father's unending love, grace and forgiveness. The meeting joined together to pray a new collect written by Mr Siôn Rhys Evans, the Diocesan Secretary, based on the life of Saint Madryn.

Eternal God, whose only Son knew the tender love of mother and father,
you called your servant Madryn to care for her family
and to teach her children the knowledge and love of your ways;
build up the family of the Church and the household of faith in grace and hope,
that all generations may know your deep and unending faithfulness;
through the same Jesus Christ, our brother and friend,
who is alive and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

The Ministry Area were invited to adopt this as our prayer and were each given a bookmark with the prayer to take home.

2. Apologies for Absence

3. Minutes from last year's meeting

3.1 A query was raised over 3. *Minutes of last meeting* and the removal of all reference to St Mary's. It was felt that it should be clear that this is referring to St Mary's, Morfa Nefyn and not Santes Fair Bryn croes. Questions were raised about whether the references that had been removed should be included in the minutes.

Action: Richard to enquire about the need to include the removed references to St Mary's in the minutes of the last meeting.

3.2 Point 7 refers to Capel Ceidio – this should be St Ceidio's Church, Ceidio.

In light of the above queries and clarifications it was **Proposed** by *Siwsan Griffith* and **Seconded** by *Toby Kenyon* that the minutes were received as a true record of the previous meeting.

All were in favour.

4. Matters Arising

There were no matters arising not otherwise covered in the agenda.

5. Adroddiadau Blynyddol

5.1 Adroddiad y Ficer- Talodd Richard deyrnged i Mr Roger Stephens Jones, a fu farw'n gynharach eleni. Siaradodd Richard am gyfraniad amhrisiadwy Roger at fywyd a gweinidogaeth Bro Madryn.

Diolchodd hefyd i Siwsan Griffith am ei rôl fel Warden y Ficer a'r gefnogaeth yr oedd hi wedi bod i Richard dros y flwyddyn a aeth heibio; i Joe Worthington a Donald Roberts am eu gwaith caled parhaus a'u gweinidogaeth fel Darllenwyr; Wardeiniaid pob eglwys; y trysoryddion; Cyngor yr Ardal Weinidogaethol (MAC) ac i'r Dr Hywel Parry-Smith fel ei gadeirydd; i Helen Franklin (sydd, gyda bendith y MAC, yn mynychu Panel Dirnadaeth yr Esgobaeth ym Mai i archwilio a dirnad ei gweinidogaeth bellach o fewn yr Eglwys yng Nghymru); i Wyn Hughes am ei weinidogaeth yn Edern; Timau'r Weinidogaeth ym Motwnnog; John Tierney am ei weinidogaeth yn Llangwnnadr a'r Parchedigion Tim Higgins, Peter Jones a Peter Kaye. Diolchodd Richard hefyd i'r tîm sy'n rhedeg Paned P'nawn a'r timau a oedd wedi rhedeg y Llwybr Stabl ym Motwnnog a Llwybr y Pasg yn Nefyn. Yn olaf, diolchodd Richard i bawb am eu parodrwydd a'u cefnogaeth dros y flwyddyn ddiwethaf hon.

"Gan geisio peidio â brolio" siaradodd Richard am y modd yr oedd Bro Madryn wedi adnabod realiti bod yn un eglwys gyda'n gilydd a'n parodrwydd i ddod at ein gilydd megis Teyrnas Dduw ar gyfer gwasanaethau a digwyddiadau. Mynegodd ei fod wrth ei fodd gyda chymaint yr ydym wedi ei gyflawni fel Ardal Weinidogaethol dros y flwyddyn a aeth heibio ac, yn arbennig, ers yr ysgrifennwyd ac y derbyniwyd ei Ddogfen Gynnig gan y MAC yn dilyn ymgynghoriad gyda Mr Simon Parton.

Cyfeiriwyd at bob pwynt o'r Ddogfen Gynnig gyda chyfeiriad arbennig at:

- **Botwnnog** – bydd gwasanaethau fore Sul yn dod i ben ym Motwnnog ar 22^{ain} Mai. Mae'r gwasanaethau Gweddi a Mawl misol wedi dechrau (a byddant yn rhedeg yn wythnosol yn ystod y gwyliau). Mae Eglwys y Bont yn Abersoch wedi ei lawnsio hefyd ac mae'n cyfarfod ar nos Sul am 4yp yn Olgra.
- **Bryncroes** – Ar 10^{fed} Ionawr trwyddedodd yr Esgob Andy Donald Roberts yn Weinidog Ffocws ar gyfer Bryncroes. Mae gweinidogaeth Donald eisoes yn profi i fod o werth mawr gyda llawer o gyffro ynghylch yr hyn y mae Duw wedi ei gynllunio nesaf.
- **Tudweiliog** – Ymgasglodd yr Ardal Weinidogaethol at ei gilydd yn Eglwys Cwyfan Sant, Tudweiliog ar gyfer gwasanaeth ar y cyd ar 31^{ain} Ionawr a ddilynir gan luniaeth yn The Lion. Bydd hyn yn parhau, fel y datganwyd yn y Ddogfen Gynnig, ar y 5^{ed} dydd Sul oni fo hwnnw'n disgyn o fewn Gwyliau Ysgol neu'r Banc.
- **Llandudwen** – Ar 3^{ydd} Gorffennaf, 2016, bydd yr Esgob eto'n ymuno â ni ym Mro Madryn, y tro hwn yn Llandudwen i drwyddedu Joe Worthington yn Weinidog Ffocws yno. Mae Joe wedi bod yn ymroddedig i'r eglwys hon ers amser hir, ac edrychwn ymlaen at gadarnhau hyn mewn cymhwyster swyddogol.
- **Nefyn** – Mae'r ymrwymiad i ymchwilio i ddatblygiad Eglwys Nefyn ar y gweill. Ar hyn o bryd mae gennym 2 bensaer yn siarad ag Esgobaeth Bangor ac yn lluniadu brasluniau cychwynnol a bras gostiadau. Bydd grŵp bychan, a benodwyd gan y MAC, yn cyfarfod â'r penseiri i drafod y datblygiadau a gwneud argymhelliad i'r MAC. Bydd hon yn broses hir er nad yw'n dal i fod ond yn ymrwymiad i ymchwilio.
- **Cyllid** – 'Rydym yn symud tuag ar gyfrif ar y cyd â Richard a Dave Best wedi bod mewn digwyddiad yn proffilio meddalwedd newydd, y telir amdano gan Esgobaeth Bangor ar ein rhan, a fydd yn gwneud hyn yn syml iawn yn wir.
- **Eglwysi Agored** – Mae John Tierney yn casglu gwybodaeth ar y modd y mae ein heglwysi'n agored i'r cyhoedd.

5. Annual Reports

5.1 Vicar's Report - Richard paid tribute to Mr Roger Stephens Jones, who died earlier this year. Richard spoke of Roger's invaluable contribution to the life and ministry of Bro Madryn.

He also thanked Siwsan Griffith for her role as Vicar's Warden and the support that she had been to Richard over the last year; Joe Worthington and Donald Roberts for their continued hard work and ministry as Readers; the Wardens of each church; the treasurers; the Ministry Area Council (MAC) and Dr Hywel Parry-Smith as its Chair; Helen Franklin (who, with the MAC's blessing, is attending a Diocesan Discernment Panel in May to explore and discern her future ministry within the Church in Wales); Wyn Hughes for his ministry in Edern; the Ministry Teams in Botwnnog; John Tierney for his ministry in Llangwnadl and the Rev'ds Tim Higgins, Peter Jones and Peter Kaye. Richard also thanked the team who run Paned P'nawn and the teams who had run the Stable Trail in Botwnnog and the Easter Trail in Nefyn. Finally, Richard thanked everyone for their willingness and support over this last year.

"Trying not to boast" Richard spoke of how Bro Madryn had recognised the reality of being one church together and our willingness to come together as the Kingdom of God for services and events. He stated that he is delighted with how much we have achieved as a Ministry Area over the last year and, in particular, since his Proposal Document was written and accepted by the MAC following the consultation with Mr Simon Parton.

Each point of the Proposal Document was addressed with particular reference to:

- **Botwnnog** – Sunday morning services will be stopping in Botwnnog on 22nd May. The monthly Prayer and Praise services have begun (and will run weekly during the holidays). Eglwys y Bont in Abersoch has also launched and meets on Sunday evenings at 4pm in Olgra.
- **Bryncroes** – On 10th January Bishop Andy licensed Donald Roberts as Focal Minister for Bryncroes. Donald's ministry is already proving to be of great value with much excitement about what God has planned next.
- **Tudweiliog** – The Ministry Area gathered together in St Cwyfan's, Tudweiliog for a joint service on 31st January followed by refreshments in The Lion. This will continue, as stated in the Proposal document, on 5th Sundays unless these fall within School or Bank Holidays.
- **Llandudwen** – On the 3rd July, 2016, the Bishop will again be joining us in Bro Madryn, this time in Llandudwen to license Joe Worthington as Focal Minister there. Joe has been dedicated to this church for a long time, and we look forward to affirming this in an official capacity.
- **Nefyn** – The commitment to investigate the development of Nefyn Church is underway. At present we have 2 architects talking to Bangor Diocese and drawing up initial sketches and rough costings. A small group, appointed by the MAC, will meet with the architects to discuss the developments and make a recommendation to the MAC. This will be a long process though it is still only a commitment to investigate.
- **Finance** – We are moving towards joint accounts with Richard and Dave Best having been to an event profiling some new software, paid for by Bangor Diocese on our behalf, which will make this very simple indeed.
- **Open Churches** – John Tierney is collecting information on how our churches are open to the public.

Finally, Richard made a plea for help. By virtue of his post, he is automatically an ex-officio trustee of several charitable trusts held within the Bro Madryn area. This is proving to be quite a burden with a large amount of work needing to be done between them all. These trusts do have

Yn olaf, gwnaeth Richard ble am gymorth. Yn rhinwedd y swydd hon, mae'n awtomatig yn ymddiriedolwr yn rhinwedd ei swydd o nifer o ymddiriedolaethau elusennol a ddelir o fewn ardal Bro Madryn. Mae hyn yn profi i fod yn gryn faich gyda swm mawr o waith angen ei wneud rhyngddynt i gyd. Mae gan yr ymddiriedolaethau hyn beth potensial i wneud effaith gadarnhaol yn ein cymunedau. Gofynnodd Richard a oedd unrhywun a fyddai'n hoffi ymuno ag ef i gynorthwyo i feddwl am yr ymddiriedolaethau hyn a'u rheoli.

5.2 Adroddiad Warden yr Eglwys – Siaradodd Siwsan Griffith hefyd am Roger Stephens Jones a'i ddoethineb a'i gyfraniad ysbrydol gwerthfawr i'r Ardal weinidogaethol. Llongyfarchodd Siwsan Fro Madryn wedyn gan ddweud nad oeddem ond prin adnabod ein gilydd 3 blynedd yn ôl, bod aberthu wedi ei wneud (ac y bydd angen ei wneud eto), ond ein bod wedi gweithio gyda'n gilydd ac y dylem roi 'canmoliaeth' i'n gilydd am bopeth yr ydym wedi ei gyflawni. Diolchodd Siwsan i Richard am ei arweinyddiaeth a gwnaeth sylw nad oedd neb gwell i'n harwain nag ef. "Da iawn, Bro Madryn!"

5.3 Synodau – Adroddodd Richard nad oedd Cynhadledd y Ddeoniaeth (fel y'i hadnabyddid) yn bod mwyach i bob pwrpas. Mae Bro Madryn yn awr yn rhan o Synod Gogledd Meirionnydd, sy'n cwmpasu'r ardal ar hyd yr arfordir cyn belled â'r Bermo ac yn cyrraedd i Flaenau Ffestiniog. Cynhelir llawer o gyfarfodydd bob blwyddyn y mae croeso i bawb iddynt. Mae'r agenda yn arferol yn cynnwys peth busnes gan yr Archddiacon a ddilynir gan gyflwyniad gan rywun gwahoddedig. Bydd y dyddiadau ar gyfer y cyfarfodydd hyn yn Newyddlenni Bro Madryn. Bydd Bro Madryn yn ethol cynrychiolwyr swyddogol ar gyfer y cyfarfodydd hyn (gweler **Etholiadau** isod).

5.4 Cynhadledd yr Esgobaeth – Adroddwyd bod cyflwyniad wedi ei roi, yng Nghynhadledd 2015, rhoddwyd cyflwyniad ar Gronfa Weinidogaethol yr Esgob ynghyd â gwybodaeth ynghylch symleiddio Cynghorau'r Esgobaeth. Bydd Bro Madryn eto'n ethol cynrychiolwyr i fynychu ar ein rhan.

6. Adroddiadau Ariannol

6.1 Eglwysi – Esboniodd Richard, cyn sefydlu Ardaloedd Gweinidogaethol bod oddeutu 160 o blwyfi yn Esgobaeth Bangor, a oedd i gyd, i bob pwrpas, yn elusennau. Roedd yn ofynnol i bob un ohonynt gynhyrchu Cyfrifon, yn cynnwys pob un o'r plwyfi sydd yn awr yn ffurfio Bro Madryn. Fel Ardal Weinidogaethol (y mae 27 ohonynt yn Esgobaeth Bangor), rydym hefyd yn elusen sengl y mae'n ofynnol iddi, drwy Gyfraith, gynhyrchu set sengl o Gyfrifon. Yr ymddiriedolwyr ar gyfer yr elusen hon yw'r MAC. Nid yw ein harferion cyfrifo presennol, felly'n gydnaws â Deddf Elusennau. Mynegodd Richard ein bod wedi cael 'cyfnod o ras' i wneud y newidiadau angenrheidiol a dod â'n cyfrifon at ei gilydd. Fel y cofnodwyd yn flaenorol, roedd Richard a Dave Best wedi mynychu digwyddiad yn proffilio'r meddalwedd newydd a fydd ar gael i reoli'r cyfrifon ar y cyd hyn.

Yna arweiniodd Richard y cyfarfod drwy'r llyfryn cyfrifon ar gyfer 2015 a oedd wedi ei ddsbarthu a'i gymeradwyo'n flaenorol gan bob Cyfarfod Cynulleidfaol Blyneddol perthnasol. Amlygodd yr hyn a ganlyn:

- Wedi rhai taliadau hwyr, oherwydd yn bennaf amgylchiadau'r tu hwnt i'n rheolaeth, cyfarfu pob eglwys â'u cyfraniadau Cronfa Weinidogaethol yr Esgob (BMF).
- Botwnnog – wrth i wasanaethau bore Sul ddod i ben mae angen i sgwrs ddigwydd yn y MAC mewn perthynas â'r fynwent sydd angen ei chynnal a'i chadw.

Gweithredu: Richard i ychwanegu hyn at agenda MAC.

- Ar dudalen 10 y papurau AVM dylid cywiro'r swm y gofynnwyd amdano ar gyfer Cronfa Weinidogaethol yr Esgob (BMF) ar gyfer Nefyn i £7,000 ac nid £22,163.

some potential to make a positive impact in our communities. Richard asked whether there is anyone who would like to draw alongside him to help think about and manage these trusts.

5.2 Churchwarden's Report – Siwsan Griffith also spoke of Roger Stephens Jones and his wisdom and valuable spiritual contribution to the Ministry Area. Siwsan then congratulated Bro Madryn saying that 3 years ago we barely knew each other, that sacrifices have been made (and will need to be made again), but that we have worked together and should give ourselves a 'pat on the back' for all that we have achieved. Siwsan thanked Richard for his leadership and commented that there was no-one better to lead us than him. "Da iawn, Bro Madryn!"

5.3 Synods – Richard reported that Deanery Conference (as it was known) effectively no longer exists. Bro Madryn is now a part of the North Meirionnydd Synod, which covers the area along the coastline as far as Barmouth and reaches into Blaeanau Ffestiniog. Several meetings are held each year to which everyone is welcome. The agenda usually includes some business from the Archdeacon followed by a presentation by an invited guest. The dates for these meetings will be in the Bro Madryn Newsletters. Bro Madryn will elect official representatives for these meetings (see **Elections** below).

5.4 Diocesan Conference – It was reported that, at the 2015 Conference, a presentation on the Bishop's Ministry Fund was given along with information about the streamlining of Diocesan Councils. Bro Madryn will again elect representatives to attend on our behalf.

6. Financial Reports

6.1 Churches – Richard explained that, prior to the establishing of Ministry Areas there were about 160 parishes in Bangor Diocese, which were all, effectively, charities. All of them were required to produce Accounts, including each of the parished which now make up Bro Madryn. As a Ministry Area (of which there are 27 in Bangor Diocese), we are also a single charity who are required, by Law, to produce a single set of Accounts. The trustees for this charity are the MAC. Our current accounting practice is not, therefore compatible with Charity Law. Richard stated that we have been given a 'leave of grace' to make the necessary changes and bring our accounts together. As previously minuted, Richard and Dave Best had attended an event profiling the new software which will be available to manage these joint accounts.

Richard then led the meeting through the accounts booklet for 2015 which had previously been distributed and approved by each relevant Annual Congregational Meeting. He highlighted the following:

- After some late payments, due mainly to circumstances beyond our control, all churches met their Bishop's Ministry Fund (BMF) contributions.
- Botwnnog – with the ceasing of Sunday morning services a conversation needs to happen at MAC regarding the cemetery which needs maintaining.
Action: Richard to add this to MAC agenda.
- On page 10 of the AVM papers the amount requested for the BMF for Nefyn should be corrected to £7,000 and not £22,163.
- On page 13 of the AVM papers Llandudwen were shown to have a BMF shortfall of £3,200. This should be corrected to £0.

6.2 Ministry Area - Dave Best, the MA Treasurer, stated that it had been a pleasure and privilege to serve as Bro Madryn's treasurer this last year. He thanked the Ministry Area and

Cynigiwyd gan *Maureen Joyce* ac **Eiliwyd** gan *Joan Bakewell* bod y Cyfrifon yn cael eu derbyn yn wir gofnod.

Roedd pawb o blaid.

Daeth Richard â'r adran hon i derfyn drwy amlygu bod gan Fro Madryn ôl-ddyledion Cwota / Cyfran y Weinidogaeth / BMF o £92,000.

14.2. Church in Wales App – The Church in Wales are asking for people to take good-quality colour photos of all churches to be included in a mobile app which they are creating. These should be sent to Richard to forward on.

14.3. Gift Direct – This is the Church in Wales' Direct Debit giving scheme and it was commended to the AVM as a good method of giving, although it might not be suitable for everybody. New forms are being made available.
