# Neges gan Richard ❖ Richard's Message

Y mae temptasiwn enfawr i bardduo'r rhai sy'n cyflawni ymosodiadau brawychol - ac mae hynny'n hollol ddealladwy. Mae'r ffrwydrad llofruddiol ym Manceinion a'r saethu o Gristnogion yn yr Aifft, y ddau beth o fewn yr wythnos ddiwethaf, yn erchyll anhygoel. Dim ond cynnyrch dynoliaeth y gallant fod, a hynny yn wyrddroëdig a mor wyrgam na fedr o ddim ymdebygu'r normalrwydd sy'n cwmpasu'r rhan fwyaf o'r byd.

Clywais ddisgrifiad o'r drwgweithredwyr fel "annynol". Yn yr un modd, yr achosodd marwolaeth Ian Brady feirniadaeth hallt codi i'r wyneb eilwaith; a hynny oherwydd ei weithredoedd a fu mor ddrwg nes iddynt fod tu hwnt i'n deall ni. Yr oedd adroddiad newyddion yn cynnwys un atebwr a fynegodd y gobaith y byddai Brady yn "pydru yn uffern".

Geiriau cryfion y dyddiau 'ma.

Fel Cristnogion, yn wir onid yw ein condemniad o'r bobl hyn cyn grymed? Wrth inni hawlio bod yn ddilynwyr Duw, yr Hwn sydd Gariad, y gallwn ni ddisgwyl barn Duw ar y gwyrddroadau di-gariad o ddynoliaeth fel rhain oherwydd y pethau erchyll a wnaethant, yn hytrach na'i gariad tuag atynt.

Ond mae'r Efengyl Gras yn warthus!

Mae'n dweud bod "pawb wedi pechu ac yn amddifad o ogoniant Duw," felly yr ydym yn yr un categori â Jihadwyr. Wedyn mae'r Efengyl yn datgan "rhoi yn rhad y mae Duw, rhoi bywyd tragwyddol yng Nghrist Iesu *ein Harglwydd.*"

There is an enormous temptation to demonise those who commit acts of terrorism - and that is perfectly understandable. The murderous explosion in Manchester and the gunning down of Coptic Christians in Egypt, both in this last week, are unimaginably horrific. They can only be the product of a humanity which has been so warped and twisted that it barely resembles the normality that otherwise encompasses the world.

I have heard the culprits described as "inhuman". Similarly, the death of Ian Brady saw a resurfacing of vitriol aimed at him because of his actions which are so wicked as to be beyond our comprehension. A news report on him included an interviewee expressing the hope that Brady would "rot in hell".

Strong words these days.

As Christians, surely our condemnation of these people is as forceful, isn't it? Claiming to be followers of the God who is Love, we can end-up excluding these love-less distortions of humanity from being subject to God's love, but not His judgement, because of what they have done.

But the Gospel of Grace is scandalous.

It says that 'all have sinned and fall short of God's glorious standard,' putting us in the same category as Jihadists, and then declares that 'the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus *our Lord.*'

Ie, i fod yn ddilynwyr Iesu, mae'n rhaid, ynghyd ag ef, ddatgan bod hyd yn oed y dihiryn ffaiddaf yn waredadwy - os daw yr Iesu yn Arglwydd iddi neu iddo.

Ble'r tynnwch chwi'r llinell rhwng pechod maddeuol a phechod anfaddeuol? Mwy na thebyg y byddwn i'n ei thynnu hi'n fymryn pellach na'r peth gwaethaf a wnaethum i erioed.

Ac os pederfynwn ni fod unrhyw un, dim ots mor erchyll a chas ei weithred, y tu hwnt i'r gafael iachwdwriaeth Duw, yna yr ydym yn lleihau Duw i fod yn orau ohonom ni, yn hytrach na llawer iawn y tu hwnt inni.

Ni chafodd y bobl sy'n cyflawni'r gweithredoedd hyn eu geni fel bomwyr hunanladdol. Cawsant eu "plethu yng nghroth mam" gan Dduw. Ein byd toredig, a ninnau yn rhan ohono, sy'n galluogu eu camffurfio. Ai dim ond ein hamgylchiadau sy'n ein cadw ni rhag cymryd yr un daith? Ac ai eu hamgylchiadau nhw sy'n atal eu taith i mewn i Grist?

Yes, to be a follower of Jesus, we must, along with Him, declare that even the most heinous villain is redeemable - if Jesus becomes their Lord.

Because where will you draw the dividing line between a forgivable sin and an unforgivable one? I would probably draw it just the other side of the worst thing I'd ever done.

And if we decide that anyone, however horrific and hateful their action, is beyond the scope of God's salvation, then don't we reduce God to being the best of us, rather than infinitely beyond us?

The people who commit these acts are not born as suicide bombers. They are 'knit together' by God in their mother's womb. It is the brokenness of our world, to which we contribute, which enables their de-formation. Is it simply our circumstances which keep us from making the same journey? And is it their circumstances which prevent their journey into Christ?

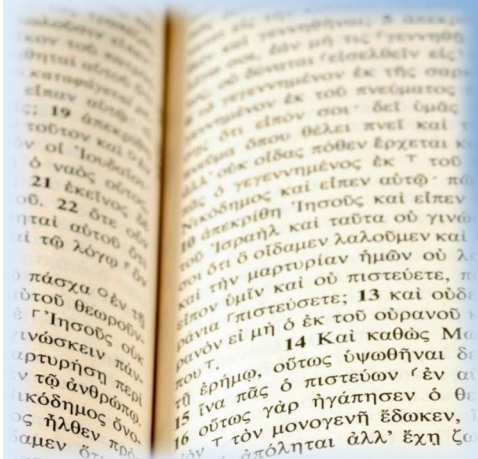
