Mae'r rhan fwyaf o bobl yn hoffi ychydig o gwyno bob hyn a hyn – er mwyn cael gwared â fo o'u system.

Mae'r amser sydd yn arwain at y Nadolig yn benodol yn hoff beth i gwyno amdano. Addurniadau yn mynd i fyny'n rhy gynnar; siopau gyda'u pwyslais ar yr anrhegion; Siôn Corn a'i garw yn gwthio Iesu i'r cefndir. Mae rhywbeth newydd wedi bod i gwyno amdano eleni - popty Greggs yn rhoi rôl selsig yn y preseb yn lle Iesu!

Wrth gwrs, yr eironi yw bod cwyno am y pethau hyn i gyd yn ein rhwystro ni i wir ddathlu Nadolig, yn cael yr un effaith yn union â'n grwgnach a'n cwyno amdanynt!

Yn wir, mae'r Adfent yn dymor o baratoi; paratoi ar gyfer Iesu.

Oherwydd ein bod yn paratoi Iddo ddod eto fel Brenin a Barnwr, mae elfen o hunanarchwilio ac edifeirwch iddo. Ond gan gadw hynny mewn cof hyd yn oed, mae'n ymwneud â pharatoi i ddathlu newyddion gogoneddus, gwych!

I suppose that becoming a father meant this change was inevitable:

I'm becoming a Grumpy Old Man.

Maybe it's because I'm doing everything in even more of a rush than before, but I'm finding myself getting frustrated more easily and annoyed more readily. And I'm perfectly happy to let my frustration show!

Most people like to have a bit of a whinge every now and then - to 'get it out of their system'.

The run-up to Christmas is a particular favourite thing to complain about. Decorations going up too early; shops trying to make it all about the presents; Santa and his reindeer pushing Jesus into the background. There's even been a new thing to complain about this year - the bakery Greggs having a sausage roll in the crib of their Nativity scene!

Of course, the irony is that we complain that all of these things are stopping us truly celebrating Christmas, when our grumbling and complaining about them has exactly the same effect!

Advent is, indeed, a season of preparation; getting ready for Jesus. Because we're getting ready for Him to come again as King and Judge, there's an element of self-examination and penitence to it. But even bearing that in mind, it's all about preparing to celebrate wonderful, glorious news!

Mae'r edrychiad hyfryd ar wyneb plentyn fore Dydd Nadolig - yn llawn ryfeddod a hapusrwydd - yn ddelwedd wych o'r Adfent.

Grumbling doesn't normally get you very far. No matter how many times I shout "but it's not even Advent yet!", I'm not going to stop the shops playing *So here it is, Merry Christmas!* in November...

Maybe the joy of the good news of Emmanuel and the rapture of His return - for which we are preparing - is a better antidote to the excesses of Father Christmas. Advent, just like the other penitential season of the Church's year, Lent, isn't meant to be joy-less. Rather it's meant to be framed with anticipation of the single most astounding moment in the history of the world.

That wonderful look on a child's face as Christmas morning dawns - full of awe and anticipation of happiness - is a great image of Advent.
