

Dros y misoedd nesaf, byddwn yn cymryd golwg ar rhai o'r pethau y byddwn ni, fel rhan o Esgobaeth Bangor, gan ganolbwyntio ar ein bywyd gyda'i gilydd. Rydym wedi dechrau gyda ein conglfeini, y trydydd ohonynt yw:

Over the coming months we will be taking a look some of the things which we, as part of Bangor Diocese, are focussing on in our life together. We have started with our principles, the third of which is:

Caru'r Byd / Loving the World

Mae'r Ysgrythur yn tystio i Dduw a garodd y byd gymaint nes iddo roi ei unig-anedig Fab (Ioan 3:16). Mae'r datganiad rhyfeddol hwn yn golygu bod Duw wedi ymrwymo ei hun yn llwyr i'w greadigaeth. Fe'n gelwir fel disgyblion Crist i garu'r byd fel y carodd ef – drwy weithredoedd anhunanol, a thrwy haelioni afradlon. Mae'r dasg o drawsnewid yn dasg ar gyfer yr Eglwys ar y cyd; ond mae nodyn personol i'w seinio yma hefyd, oblegid mae'n gweithredoedd bychain, dyddiol o garedigrwydd a daioni hefyd yn dyst i'n ffydd yn Nuw. Carwn y byd drwy arddangos arwyddion y groes a'r atgyfodiad mewn ffyrdd mesuradwy a chlr.

The Scriptures bear witness to the God who loved the world so much that he gave his only begotten Son (John 3:16). This extraordinary statement means that God committed his very being to the world he created and sustains. Disciples are people who also love the world by their selfless acts of giving and generous attitudes. The task of transformation is one the Church embraces together; but there is a personal imperative to be sounded here as well, for each of our small, daily, individual acts of kindness and goodness show faith in God. To love the world is to show the signs of the cross and resurrection in measurable and clear ways.
