Mae'r dryswch a'r drwgdybiaeth ar draws y DU ynghylch Brexit yn ddibwys o'i gymharu â marwolaeth ac atgyfodiad Mab Duw.

Mae ein dod ynghyd ar gyfer y Gyfarfod Festri Blynyddol i ystyried a chynllunio am ein haddoliad a'n tyst gyda'n gilydd yn fryn dibwys o'i gymharu â'r digwyddiad copa-mynydd y mae Duw yn cyflawni ei Addewid Cyfamod.

Ond... mae manylion bach Stori y Pasg, eiliadau agos y Iesu sy'n marw a'r Iesu a atgyfodwyd yn cyffwrdd â bywydau pobl, yn golygu bod y digwyddiad mwyaf erioed yn effeithio ac yn siarad â phawb arall mewn profiad dynol.

Felly i'n cenedl ranedig, mae'r Pasg yn dweud 'rhowch eich gobaith ynof fi' a 'charu eich gilydd'. I'n CFB, mae'r Pasg yn dweud 'Atgyfododd Ef' a 'Ewch a gwneud disgyblion'.

Yr allwedd, fel erioed, yw clywed yr hyn y mae Duw yn ei ddweud. Felly, gweddiwch dros ein Senedd a'r holl wleidyddion, y byddai ewyllys Duw yn cael ei wneud yn ein wlad. Ac ar gyfer ein CFB, dewch i weddio yr un peth; y byddai pob llais arall bod yn dawel ac y byddem yn dirnad sut mae Duw yn ein dysgu ac yn ein harwain i fod yn Eglwys yn y lle hwn. Mae angen **chi** yn yr CFB. Dylech fod yno os gallwch chi o bosibl.

In one sense, it's simply ridiculous to talk about the events of Easter even on the same page as anything which faces us here and now.

The confusion and mistrust across the UK regarding Brexit is a mere ripple compared to the death and resurrection of the Son of God.

Our gathering for an Annual Vestry Meeting to reflect on and plan for our worship and witness together is an insignificant bump compared to the mountain-top event of God fulfilling His Covenant Promise.

Any yet... the small details of the Easter Story; the intimate moments of the dying and the resurrected Jesus touching people's lives means that the biggest event in history affects and speaks to all else in human experience.

So to our divided nation, Easter says 'place your hope in me' and 'love one another'.

To our AVM, Easter says 'He is Risen' and 'Go and make disciples'.

The key, as ever, is hearing what God is saying. So, pray for our Parliament and all politicians, that God's will would be done in our land. And for our AVM, come and pray the same; that all other voices would be stilled and that we would together discern how God is teaching us and leading us to be His Church in this place. **You** are invited to the AVM. You should be there if you possibly can.

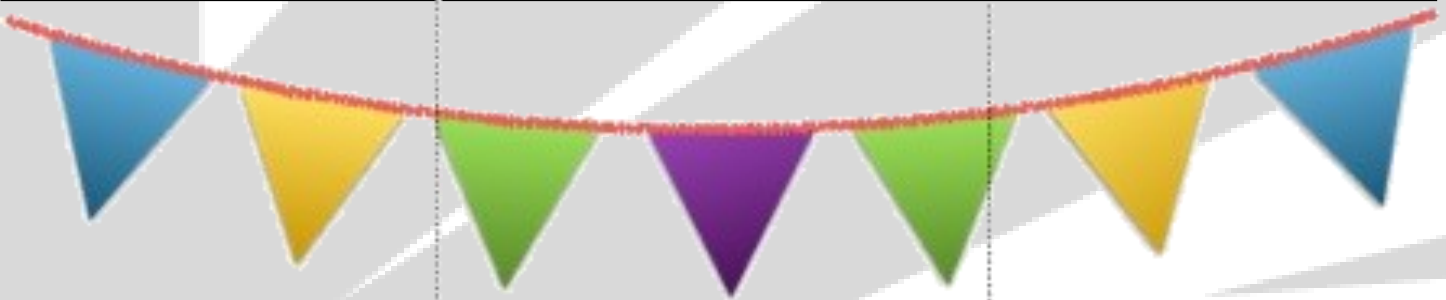

# Apêl Dr James / Dr James Appeal

*Bishop Andy writes...*

Many will remember how our diocese has supported the training of a doctor in Uganda over a period of years called Dr James Akello. Coming from the Lango region of our partner diocese in northern Uganda, he succeeded through the primary and secondary education system during a time of war and insurgency.

A team from Bangor met James during their visit to Lango in 2006 and subsequently invited the Diocese to contribute towards his medical training at the Kampala International Medical University. Following his four years at University Dr James returned to Lira to work as full time doctor at the hospital there, in the Children's department.

I met him in the summer of 2014. During that visit, I witnessed the trauma of children struggling with malnourishment. Very often it is not the lack of food, but of education which leads to terrible rates of infant mortality.

The opportunity then arose for Dr James to obtain further qualifications to become a Consultant Paediatrician, and he asked whether our Diocese would contribute towards his education once more.

Dr James was one of 15 people chosen for the course from over 120 applications. The hospital in Lira agreed that his family could remain in one of their houses, whilst Dr James is following the course. The course is run from Kampala and southern Uganda, so Dr James is a 7 hour bus journey away from his family, and only gets to see them when he has holiday. Dr James is having to support his family, himself and pay towards his course fees during this period of training.

From the Diocese, we agreed to contribute £3,000 per annum over a period of 3 years to help Dr. James. So far we have completed 2 years and contributed £6,000.

Dr James is so grateful to us. He is a Christian with a vocation who believes that God has given him the gifts to be a doctor, to serve the people of his home in northern Uganda and to be one small part of bringing and sharing medical knowledge that can improve the lives of children and their parents in his home area.

Please do help, if you can. Children from one of the poorest areas of God's world will benefit for many years to come.
