Unbelievably, it is a year since I began my curacy amongst you all and a year since my ordination as priest in Bangor Cathedral. As I pray for colleagues who are preparing to make their own vows and exercise their own vocations to ordained and licensed ministries, it's incredible to me that a year has passed so quickly! So it's appropriate for me to thank you all for your kindness, your support and your generosity over this past year as you've welcomed me here in Bro Madryn.

We have moved through the year together, marking the seasons with the church calendar - a calendar of opportunities to engage with God's story and reflect on our part in that story. The cycle continues, but we are not the same as we travel through each celebration, so that every season is fresh and teaches us something new about the height, depth and breadth of God's love for us.

Even before the restructuring of St David's begins, members of the congregations are starting new projects and living out the biblical mandate to love God and love neighbour: the Wednesday Coffee Mornings in St David's and Caffi Colled are but 2 examples of how simply being open and present can make a difference. Other visions and hopes are bubbling away, for our young people and for the community over the summer. The Holy Spirit is at work in a powerful way, drawing people in and sparking ideas and energy! I'm excited to see what happens over the next 2 years!

Surrounding all this, of course, is the deep prayer life of Bro Madryn. Without each and every venture being rooted and grounded in God's

Reading the Bible together and sharing fellowship is one of the joys of being part of the Church - but it's also a really good way to see your faith grow!

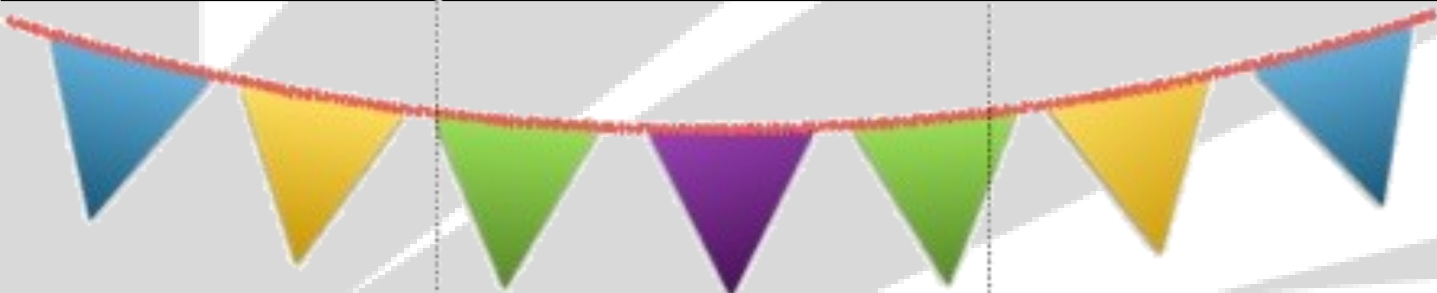
