Neges gan Sara ❖ Sara's Message

Yr wythnos diwethaf, buom yn dathlu dau achlysur arbennig yn ein hanes crefyddol — 'ben-blwydd' yr eglwys ar y Sulgwyn, neu Pentecost, a dydd gŵyl y Santes Melangell (Mercher 27ain o Fai). Y forwyn ifanc, Melangell, y brenin, Brochwel Ysgithrog, a'r sgwarnog rhyngthon nhw yn llochesi o dan glogyn Melangell yw'r ddelwedd sydd wedi cael ei gyfleu i ni mewn sawl darlun. Yn y cyfarfod hwn, y mae'r ferch yn uniaethu ag ofn ac angen yr anifail gwyllt ac yn ei amddiffyn rhag yr heliwr.

Mae'r ddau ddigwyddiad yn dangos i ni rhywbeth dirgel a grymus am waith yr Ysbryd Glan — sydd yn newid bywydau ar yr amser iawn ac yn modd unigryw i'r sefyllfa. Symudodd y disgyblion allan o'u lloches yn yr ystafell i'w tasg sanctaidd yn y byd. Symudodd Melangell allan o'r byd i'w thasg sanctaidd yn ei chymuned gysegredig. Mae yna amser i symud allan i'r byd, ac amser i gilio, a'r un Ysbryd sydd yn ein harwain.

Ar adeg ble mae llochesu yn hanfodol, ni ddylem ddisgyn i'r camsyniad mai cilio rhag y byd rydym. Unwaith eto, mae deall ofn ac anghenion eraill yn medru ein harwain at gydsafiad a thosturi ac yn agor calonnau i bresenoldeb yr Ysbryd, yn ein mysg. Pob bendith a chadwch yn ddiogel. Amen.

This last week we celebrated two special occasions in our religious history — the 'birthday' of the church on Pentecost, and the feast day of Saint Melangell (Weds 27th May). The young woman, Melangell, the king Brochwel Ysgithrog, and the hare between them, sheltering under Melangell's cloak is a familiar image from many pictures. In this meeting the young woman identifies with the fear and need of the wild animal and protects it from the hunter.

The two events show us something of the power and mystery of the work of the Holy Spirit — which changes lives at the right time and according to each unique circumstance. The disciples moved from their refuge in the upper room to their sacred task in the world. Melangell moved out of the world into her sacred task in her holy community. There is a time to move out into the world and a time to retreat; and the same Spirit leads us.

At a time when sheltering is essential, we shouldn't fall into the mistake of thinking we're retreating from the world. Once again, understanding the fears and needs of others can lead us to solidarity and compassion and open our hearts to the presence of the Spirit in our midst.
